New Seeding: 1-2 lbs. per 1000 ft² (5-10 g/m²)
 Interseeding: 2-4 lbs. per 1000 ft² (10-20 g/m²)




L-93 XD in the 2014 NTEP fairway tee trial at Washington State University


2015 Quality Data - Average
